

# Anomaly of the vestibulum oris, diastema, tremata

## Anomaly of the vestibulum oris

- Shallow vestibulum

### 1. Primary shallow vestibulum

Congenital  
High attachment of mentalis muscle

### 1. Secondary shallow vestibulum

due to gingival recession (missing of attached gingiva)

- Anomaly in attachment of labial frenulum

### 1. Gingival attachment (normally the attachment is mucosal)

#### 1. Papillary attachment

#### 1. Through the papilla attachment

## PULL SYMPTOM

- The gingiva around the pathological attachment of the frenulum has whitish (pale) colour

## PULL SYNDROME

- Follows pull symptom
- Results in opening of the interdental space between the two central incisors (diastema formation)

## Tremata

- Single space --> trema
- Many spaces --> tremata (spacing)
