



# Azotemia

## Azotemia vs Uremia; AKI vs CKD; ESRD:



We use the term azotemia to refer to increased levels of urea, nitrate and creatinine in the blood due to a decrease in GFR. It can be divided into **prerenal** (e.g. hypoperfusion of the kidney), **renal** and **postrenal** (obstruction in the outflow tract).
