

# Dennie-Morgan line



**Dennie-Morgan line** (also **Dennie-Morgan infraorbital fold**) is a feature on the lower eyelid occurring in atopy. It is a fold formed by swelling of the eyelid, usually present bilaterally. It cannot be used as a stand-alone diagnostic criteria, but may help in making the diagnosis in association with other symptoms.<sup>[1]</sup>
