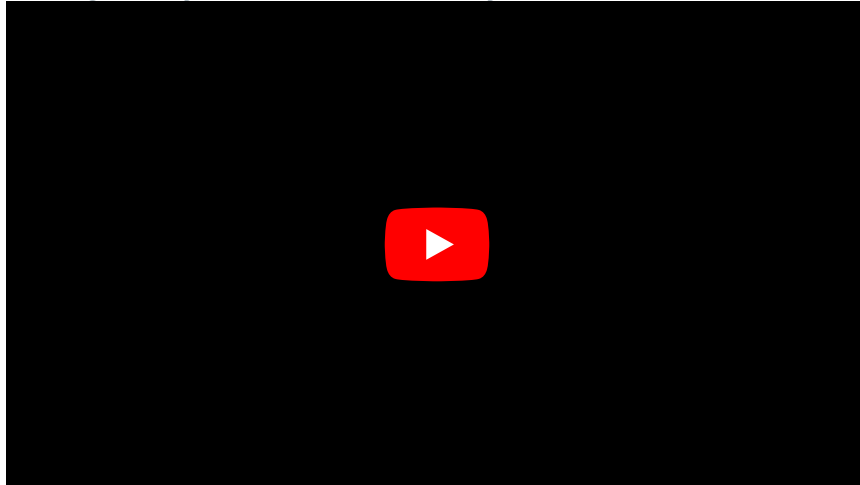


Isosthenuria

A condition where **urine has the same relative density as plasma (i.e. 1.010)**. It occurs when the kidneys lose their ability to dilute and concentrate urine. Isosthenuria is a serious symptom of kidney damage.
