- Chondroma (according to location: enchondroma, ekchondroma)
- Juxtacortical (parosteal) osteosarcoma
- Osteochondroma (exostosis osteocartilaginea)
- Chondroblastoma
- Chondrosarcoma
- Ewing's sarcoma (PNET)
- Chordoma
