

Primary aggregation

English: Primary aggregation is a process influenced by the platelet activator - **thrombin**.

Because of it and other stimulating substances, platelets can aggregate (cluster).

The **mediator** of this reversible aggregation is **fibrinogen**. Platelets have receptors for fibrinogen on their surface.
